




Dear Students:

- The Faculty of Nursing was established as a higher institute for nursing by Presidential Decree No. 301 in 1992, affiliated with the Faculty of Medicine at Zagazig University, Benha Branch.
- Presidential Decree No. 200 of 2000 was issued to convert the Higher Institute of Nursing into the Faculty of Nursing at Zagazig University, Benha Branch.
- Ministerial Decree No. 3180 was issued on November 21, 2005, to establish the internal regulations for the Faculty of Nursing (Bachelor's degree) at Benha University

Leaderships the faculty

- On September 1, 1993, Prof. Samia Mustafa Rashid, Professor of Parasitology at the Faculty of Medicine, was appointed as the general supervisor of the Higher Institute of Nursing affiliated with the Faculty of Medicine.
- Prof. Ahmed Khashaba, Professor of Pediatrics at the Faculty of Medicine, was assigned to supervise the Higher Institute of Nursing affiliated with the Faculty of Medicine from 1998 until 2001.
- In 2001, Prof. Abdel Rahim Saad Shouleh was assigned to supervise the Higher Institute of Nursing affiliated with the Faculty of Medicine from 2001 until 2003.





• On February 6, 2003, a decision was issued by the University President appointing Prof. Abdel Rahim Saad Shouleh as the first dean and founder of the Faculty of Nursing in Benha.

Mechanism for attracting international students

Benha University's Faculty of Nursing is committed to supporting international students, reinforcing its image as an international faculty by providing a variety of services and facilitating the administrative processes related to their registration and enrollment in the faculty. Additionally, the faculty promotes its distinctive and diverse academic programs to foster cooperation and communication between the Faculty of Nursing and various institutions worldwide.

The strategic vision for supporting international students focuses on maintaining the prestigious standing of Benha University's Faculty of Nursing as one of the most renowned nursing faculties in the Arab world. It also aims to enhance its competitiveness at both the regional and international levels, which is expected to have a significant impact on improving the quality of the educational process, raising the standards of its faculty, students and administrative structure.

"Mechanism for attracting international students":

- 1. Establish Communication with Cultural Representation Offices: Engage with all cultural representation offices of Arab and African countries located in Egypt to introduce them to the faculty's programs and attract new students.
- 2. **Invite Key Officials for Exchange and Cultural Representation**: Invite officials responsible for student exchange and cultural representation from Arab and African embassies to visit the university and the faculty, and organize promotional lectures for them.
- 3. **Organize an International Student Camp**: Host an international student camp to promote and showcase the faculty's postgraduate programs.
- 4. Utilize Distance Learning: Implement distance learning to enable international students to follow the faculty's academic programs





while residing in their home countries, especially in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

- 5. Facilitate Solutions for International Students: Assign a dedicated official within the faculty to address and resolve any challenges faced by international students.
- 6. Leverage Faculty on Secondment: Task faculty members on secondment at other universities with promoting the faculty's academic programs in the countries they are based in.
- 7. **Provide Internship Opportunities Abroad**: Allow international students to complete their internship period in hospitals within their home countries.
- 8. Hold Regular Meetings with International Students: Conduct regular meetings with international students to introduce registration procedures, faculty programs, and academic/research activities, while addressing any obstacles to enrollment.

Admission Rules for international Students in Postgraduate Studies

□ The university's faculties accept international students with a cumulative grade of "Pass" in their undergraduate studies for admission to postgraduate studies in one of the university's faculties. The student may be required to take some supplementary courses based on the decision of the Supreme Council of Universities, provided that the remaining admission and registration rules stipulated in the internal regulations of each faculty are applied.

Enrollment is opened based on the instructions of the General Administration for Internationals for each academic year.





Required documents according to the general administration rules for the admission and granting of *international* students:



1. Three Data Forms:

• Three completed data forms written clearly, containing the student's name as it appears on their passport and academic certificate, along with their address in their home country and in the host country. The forms must include the opinion of the faculty and university, certified with their stamps.

2. Clear Copies of Qualifications:

 A clear and certified copy of the qualifications obtained by the student.

3. Equivalency Certificate:

• A copy of the equivalency certificate from the Supreme Council of Universities.

4. Passport Copy:

• A complete and clear copy of the passport that is valid for more than a year (authenticated).





5. Embassy Letter:

• A copy of the letter from the embassy indicating the institution where the student will study and the academic degree they wish to pursue, matching the data form and academic year.

6. Four Copies of the Information Form:

 Four copies of the information form detailing all relevant data.

7. Electronic Registration Proof:

 Proof of online registration on the General Administration for Internationals' website (<u>www.HOME/CASM.EDU.EG</u>) and the electronic registration site for international postgraduate students at Benha University (http://www.mis.bun.edu.eg/BENHA/ui/login page.aspx).

8. Declaration of Non-Enrollment:

• A declaration from the student stating that they are not enrolled in any other nursing program at any other university.





How to Apply for Enrollment as an international Student:

1. Registration on the "Study in Egypt" Platform:

• The international student must register on the "Study in Egypt" platform. The General Administration for Acceptance and Grants of International Students at the Ministry of Higher Education will review the student's data and verify their documents and qualifications.

2. File Submission:

• The student's file will be sent to the International Management Department at the university. Once the International Management Department confirms the student's data, the file will be forwarded to the respective faculty.

3. Approval Process:

• The faculty's international officer will receive the student's file and obtain approval from the Faculty Council. The student will then receive a preliminary acceptance letter.

4. Payment Authorization:

• The faculty's international officer will issue a payment authorization for the student's tuition fees.

Fees for International Students

The fees have been updated according to Article 271, Clause (b) of the Executive Regulations by the Prime Minister's Decision No. 27 of 2016 issued on 10/1/2016 for international postgraduate students as follows:

- Initial Registration Fee: \$1,500
- **Annual Tuition Fees**: \$ 5,000 for the Faculty of Nursing.

If a student holds undergraduate and master's degrees from outside Egypt, they must have these qualifications accredited by the Supreme Council of Universities.





Admission Procedures

Article 3: After obtaining preliminary acceptance for undergraduate or postgraduate studies at one of the university's faculties, the student's complete documents are sent to the General Administration for Acceptance and Grants of International Students in Cairo for verification. The administration will inform the university's international management of the final decision (acceptance or rejection) regarding the student's enrollment.

Article 4: Payment authorization for the prescribed fees must be obtained from the postgraduate studies office at the relevant faculty, and payment is to be made through the designated accounts in the university's accounting office.

Payment Deadline: The deadline for paying enrollment and tuition fees for international postgraduate students is as follows:

1. For Diploma Students:

• The deadline is the end of the academic year, coinciding with the second-round exams in faculties that offer them, even if more than a year has passed since the student's enrollment.

2. For Master's and Doctoral Students:

- Fees are paid per semester according to the Supreme Council of Universities' decision dated 23/5/2016, which states:
- The semester-based payment system applies to international students in postgraduate programs across Egyptian universities.
- Students who complete their studies in the first half of the academic year and are awarded degrees (Diploma, Master's, Doctorate) will be charged only for the first half of the academic year's tuition fees, without being liable for the full annual fees.



Fee Payment Regulations

Article 5: Tuition fees for international students are to be paid in US dollars as per Article (271) of the Law Regulating Universities.

Article 6: The registration fee is paid once for each stage (Diploma, Master's, Doctorate).

Article 7: Tuition fees for the entire academic year must be paid.

Article 8: Discount Rates are as follows:

- For Palestinian Students:
 - A 50% discount on fees has been granted since the 2007/2008 academic year for postgraduate students who obtained their bachelor's degree from Palestine.
- For Sudanese Students:
 - A 10% payment of the total registration and tuition fees has been approved by the Minister since 11/4/2002.
